## PHILOSOPHY STATEMENT

**BABY 'N ME** courses are offered by Bellingham Technical College. Parents/caregivers, infants, and an instructor meet together to learn more about infants and their families. The participants are given a chance each week to share the joys and challenges of parenting. Each week a topic relating to infant growth and development is presented by the instructor. Following are the general course goals:

- 1. To foster optimal infant development through parent(s) and infant interaction, parent-to-parent interaction, and parent group interactions.
- To establish a basic support system by sharing with and receiving input from other parents; exploring positive and negative feelings toward infants and toward parenthood.
- 3. To gain a beginning understanding and knowledge of infant development, both emotional and physical, through class observations of parents and infants and also through sensual stimulation.
- To help parents gain a beginning and/or ongoing confidence in their parental role in the areas of discipline, nutrition, safety, childhood illnesses and emergencies, and managers of family resources.
- 5. To develop an awareness of the joys of the parent-infant relationship and the importance of positive interaction between parent and child.
- 6. To familiarize parents with the various community agencies available to help meet their needs and increase their competency as a family unit.

The general purpose of these courses is to improve the parenting skills of the students thereby providing infants with a safe, healthy, enriched, happy environment in which to grow.
